
सन्देश

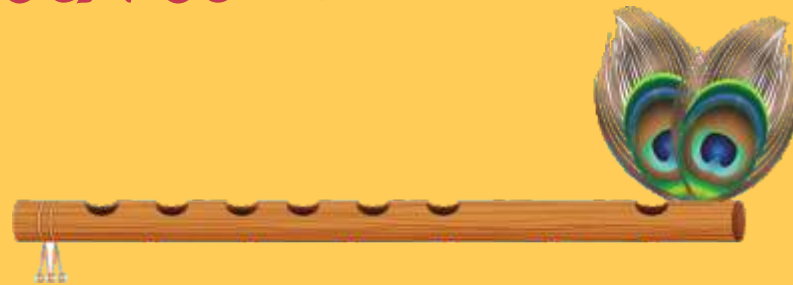
Janamashtmi CELEBRATION

Planetarium ACTIVITY

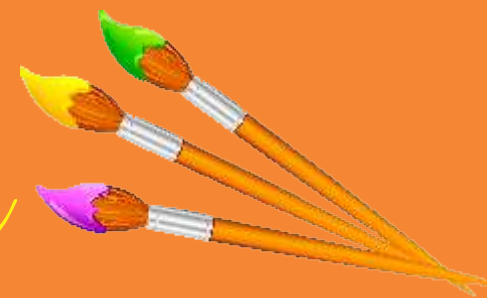

With the painful thoughts gone, I find solace.

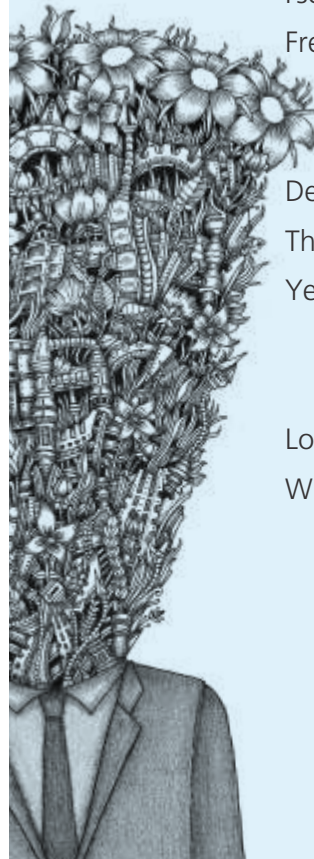

Chandrayaan 3



The journey of ISRO, from carrying rocket parts on bicycle to making history on August 23, 2023 by successfully landing on the south pole of the moon, has been incredible. With this, India became the first nation to land on the moon's south pole and the fourth to land successfully on Earth's only natural satellite.

In the vast expanse of the cosmos, where the boundaries of human achievement are constantly being pushed, India has once again etched its name in annals of space exploration with the triumphant success of Chandrayaan – 3. One of the key elements that made Chandrayaan-3 a success was the collaborated effort of brilliant minds from ISRO. Scientists, engineers and technicians worked tirelessly, pouring their expertise into every aspect of the mission.

ISRO had undertaken two previous missions to the moon, namely, Chandrayaan I and Chandrayaan II. Chandrayaan I was launched in 2008 and lasted till 2009 after communications with it were lost. The mission, among other things, tested a crash landing on the lunar surface. Chandrayaan II launched in 2019 attempted a soft landing on the moon but failed. The 3rd Mission, Chandrayaan-3 took into account the draw backs and lessons learnt form the second mission. It took off on July 19, 2023 from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh. The lander was named Vikram and rover Pragyaan. Its main objective was to conduct many scientific experiments. On August 23, the mission successfully reached its destination.
